The 59th Annual Conference of ISACON Delhi Chapter - 1th Virtual Conference

Greetings from Team ISACON2020

The 59th Annual Conference of ISACON Delhi Branch was scheduled in April this year. The venue, Le Meridea was booked, scientific programme was finalized and the preparation was on full swing when complete lockdown was announced by the Government due to outbreak of Covid-19. The conference was proposed to be cancelled and it was decided that the money paid by delegates would be refunded.

However, Dr Anil Kumar Jain, the organizing chairperson and ex-president ISA Delhi, along with present ISA Delhi office bearers and GC member Dr Rajiv Gupta decided to conduct the annual conference virtually. Initially we were skeptical and not sure how to conduct virtual conference, with multiple halls, for 3 days. Thanks to our audiovisual team, we learnt the technicalities. Organizing an event like this during these times was tough as half of our department was busy managing Coxid ICUs and increasing OT list in non-Coxid OTs. This gine us limited manpower and time to manage. But with constant motivation from UK, Mali Ka guidance from Dr J. Sood, we managed to conduct the 1" Virtual Annual Conference of ISA Delbi.

We were overwhelmed by the response shown by our delegates. Initially we had planned only one session of free paper in one of the 2 halls. But thanks to technology, delegates from outside NCR like Latur, Karnataka, Anjoula and Lujung registered and sent abstracts for free paper & e-poster presentation.

We had 4 halls running simultaneously for 3 days with one hall dedicated for free paper presentation and one hall for e-poster presentation.

We had approximately 420 registered delegates and while around 600 participants attended the conference each day. It was available live on YouTube as well.

We would like to thank our secretarial team for working tirelessly and meticulously.







SUMMARY OF RECOMMENDATIONS Recommendations	Level of Recommendation
Adult Section	(GRADE)
Clear liquids should be allowed up to 2 h prior to administration of sedation or anaesthesia.	Strong
The volume of clear liquid consumed may be restricted to < 450mL, 2 h prior to administration of sedation or anaesthesia.	Weak
Non-clear liquids may be allowed up to 4 h prior to administration of sedation or anaesthesia.	Weak
Light meals may be allowed up to 6 h prior to administration of sedation or anaesthesia.	Weak
If the patient has consumed heavy meals, it may be prudent to wait for at least 10 h prior to administration of sedation or anaesthesia.	Weak
Heavy meal consumption is not advisable the night prior to surgery.	Strong
Routine use of aspiration prophylaxis in adequately fasted patients is not advised prior to administration of sedation or anaesthesia.	Strong
Aspiration prophylaxis is advised in high risk patients as identified by the anaesthesiologist.	Weak
H2 receptor blockers, proton pump inhibitors and prokinetic drugs may be used as prophylaxis in high risk patients.	Weak
Obstetric Section	
Women in early or late pregnancy when administered sedation or anaesthesia may be considered to be at high risk for aspiration.	Weak
Clear liquids may be allowed up to 2 h prior to administration of sedation or anaesthesia in pregnant women.	Weak
Non-clear liquids may be allowed up to 4 h prior to administration of sedation or anaesthesia in pregnant women.	Weak
Light meals may be allowed up to 6 h prior to administration of sedation or anaesthesia in pregnant women.	Weak
If the pregnant woman has consumed a heavy meal, it may be prudent to wait for at least 10 h prior to administration of sedation or anaesthesia.	Weak
Heavy meal consumption is not advisable the night prior to surgery in pregnant women.	Strong
Pregnant women requiring sedation or anaesthesia should be administered aspiration prophylaxis.	Strong
H2 receptor blockers, proton pump inhibitors either alone or in combination with prokinetic drugs can be administered for aspiration prophylaxis.	Weak
Clear liquids can be allowed orally 8 h after caesarean section under regional/ general anaesthesia.	Strong

Recommendations	Level of Recommendation (GRADE)
Paediatric Section	
Consumption of water, up to 3mL/kg should be allowed until 1 h prior to administration of anaesthesia.	Strong
Consumption of clear liquids other than water, up to 3 mL/kg can be allowed until 2 h prior to administration of anaesthesia.	Weak
Human milk and fully skimmed non-human milk can be allowed until 4 h prior to administration of anaesthesia.	Weak
Non-clear liquids, non-human milk, formula feeds, light breakfast or light meal may be allowed until 6 h prior to administration of anaesthesia.	Weak
The attending anaesthesiologist can decide for or against the administration of aspiration prophylaxis in adequately fasted children.	Weak
The attending anaesthesiologist can decide on the duration of fasting for procedural sedation within operating room or at remote location.	Weak
The oral consumption of clear liquids in the postoperative period should be resumed at the earliest where no medical or surgical contraindications exist.	Strong
Bariatric Section	
Obese individuals may be considered to be at higher risk for aspiration in comparison to non-obese individuals when administered sedation or general anaesthesia.	Weak
In obese individuals, the advice on preoperative fasting practices may be the same as in non-obese individuals prior to the administration of sedation or anaesthesia.	Weak
Aspiration prophylaxis may be administered in obese patients prior to the administration of sedation or anaesthesia.	Weak
H2 receptor blockers, proton pump inhibitors either alone or in combination with prokinetic drugs can be administered for aspiration prophylaxis.	Weak
Gastric Ultrasonography Section	
Gastric ultrasonography may be used as a bedside tool for assessing the quality and quantity of gastric contents in the preoperative period.	Weak
The quality and quantity of gastric contents should be assessed in the right lateral decubitus position.	Strong

Light Meal	Bread slice (1 no.), Cream of soups, Curd rice (150 g), Dal rice (150 g), Poha (100 g), Phulka with vegetable (1 with 4 spoons of vegetable), Curd (200 ml), Milk shake with fruit (200 ml), Milk and corn flakes (1 cup), Idli with sambhar (1 no.), Poha / Avalakki soaked in water and eaten (30 g), Puffed rice (150 g), Marie biscuits (4 no.) with milk 150 ml, Glucose biscuit (4 no.) with milk 150 ml.	4-6 h

- 1. All volumes mentioned in brackets are with respect to adult patients only.
- 2. Volumes of clear liquid are taken as <450 mL unless specifically mentioned.

Know your Anaesthesiologist

- Anaesthesiologist is the specialist doctor who makes your surgery pain free and keeps you safe and comfortable during surgery.
- Anaesthesiologist is qualified and trained just like your surgeon or gynecologist/obstetrician.
- Anaesthesiologist administers medications including blood transfusion, and monitors your breathing, heart rate, blood pressure, consciousness and other organ functions during your surgery.
- Your anaesthesiologist will examine you before your surgery and help you allay your anaesthesia concerns and anxiety.
- Your anaesthesiologist decides in consultation with your surgeon and yourself, the best anaesthesia technique for your surgery.
- Your anaesthesiologist takes care of you before and during your surgery, and until you are awake, comfortable and safely recovered from anaesthesia.
- Anaesthesiologist have expertise in emergency resuscitation, Intensive Care Unit (I.C.U.), disaster management.
- Anaesthesiologist, in addition, takes care of you for other interventions requiring pain relief or sedation outside the operation theatre such as in painless childbirth, CT, MRI, Angioplasty and Endoscopy.
- Anaesthesiologist also takes care of you in the 'Pain Clinic' for relief of immediate and long-term pain due to surgery, trauma, nerves, muscles, joints, cancer and other painful conditions.

Know about Anaesthesia

- You will require 'Anaesthesia' for a pain free and safe surgery.
 Various anaesthesia techniques can be used depending on your surgical procedure.
- You can participate in your own safety by cooperating with your anaesthesiologist and following their instructions carefully:
 - Tell about your coexisting illnesses, smoking, alcohol, medications, allergies, medical history and investigations.
 - ii. Tell if you are pregnant or breastfeeding.
 - iii. Follow your fasting and medication orders strictly.
- You will have an intravenous cannula inserted before your anaesthesia.
- 4. Your anaesthesia technique could be any one or combination of the following:
 - Local anaesthesia makes the surgical area numb.
 In this you have the choice to stay awake or sleep with medication.
 - Regional anesthesia blocks the nerves to make a particular region numb and is given by an injection in the back or in the limb.
 In this you have the choice to stay awake or sleep with

In this you have the choice to stay awake or sleep with medication.

- iii. General anaesthesia makes you unconscious with medicines and may require a breathing tube in your throat. In this you will gain consciousness soon after surgery, except under certain situations.
- You will be taken care of by your anaesthesiology team and monitored until you are awake and safely recovered from anaesthesia.
- Anaesthesia is very safe but all procedures can have some risks. Talk to your anaesthesiologist about your concerns.
- You must understand about your anaesthesia technique before you give your consent. This is important for us and for your own safety.
