Message

Dear fellow anaesthesiologists,

Greetings from your President for the New Year 2022.

First, let me thank you all for electing me to the highest post of the Society unopposed. This shows your faith in me and I consider this as your recognition for the work done during my term as Hon. Secretary of the Society. I am indebted to you and I will strive to fulfil your wishes and try to stand up to your expectations.

The Indian Society of Anaesthesiologists (ISA) has more than 36,000 members now and is one of the most democratic associations in the world. Otherwise, I who belong to a small town of 50,000 population and a city branch having less than 15 members would not have become President of the Society.

I will lead the Society with the help of you all and the guidance of our seniors and experienced members and teachers. We can do a lot together and **WE WILL DO IT TOGETHER**.

I have some ideas in my mind for the progress of ISA and our members during this Platinum Jubilee year, the Amruth Mahotsav year of ISA, which I want to implement with your concurrence and support and participation. Amongst them all, I have serious plans to address the issue of the financial status and remuneration for the Private Practitioners. I also feel that the ISA has the responsibility to see that they work with due respect and with the 'best', not the 'minimal' working standards. In this regard, the ISA National Guidelines of practice covering various aspects of clinical practice are expected to guide the members for a safe practice. Safety of the members is equally important as the Safety of the patients. ISA will also facilitate updating the knowledge of the private practitioners with focus on hands-on training on contemporary topics.

Regarding ISA Family Benevolent Fund (FBF), let me restate that the scheme is focussed for the financial well-being of the spouse and children of our young members, in the event of the member's demise. It is for the benefit of the dependent spouse/ children when earning member

is lost at an early age. Its utility for elderly members and their spouse /children is obviously less as they would be financially well settled. Hence, I appeal to members to understand the noble cause we are attending to and make best use of the Fund.

The Conference of the Association of the member countries of the South Asian Association for Regional Cooperation (SAARC), the SAARC Association of Anaesthesiologists (SAARC AA), will be held after a gap of 3 years, and in India, after a 10 year gap. The Conference coincides with the ISA Amruth Mahotsav year, and I expect to be a grand event in God's own country, scheduled to be held from 12th to 14th August 2022. I invite you all to participate in this mega event.

Further, the Amruth Mahotsav of ISA is planned to be celebrated in a grand style with ISA National supported activities in every City, Metro and State Branches. Along with the ISA activities, the Indian Resuscitation Council (IRC) activities will be clubbed so that the efforts of ISA and IRC to train our population in resuscitation gains further traction. I aim to maintain cordial relationship with the Indian College of Anaesthesiologists and Anaesthesia sub speciality and super speciality associations with the idea that sharing academics for the benefit of all anaesthesia practitioners.

The ISA Fellowships (Inland and International) will continue this year along the popular ISA sponsored educational activities such as CMEs, Workshops and PG Assemblies. The ISA National will make efforts to reach to the Government of India for institution of an Annual Award in the name of first lady anaesthesiologist of the world Rupa Bai Furdoonji for an eminent anaesthesiologist.

And I request all our members to participate in maximum strength in our own National Conference, the ISACON 2022 at Shillong, hopefully a physical meeting after the unfortunate nature-thrust, mainly online conference during 2021.

Before ending I request each and every member of City, Metro and State Branches to formulate some activities to observe Amruth Mahotsav in most befitting manner. Some suggestions by me are pain-free post operative period, Creating awareness about our speciality and our work among patients and common public, arranging CPR classes for students and public, arranging family meeting at City level, respecting at least one of your anaesthesia teachers on National Teachers Day, gifting of books written by anaesthesiologists (anecdotes from OT or our work etc.) to others.

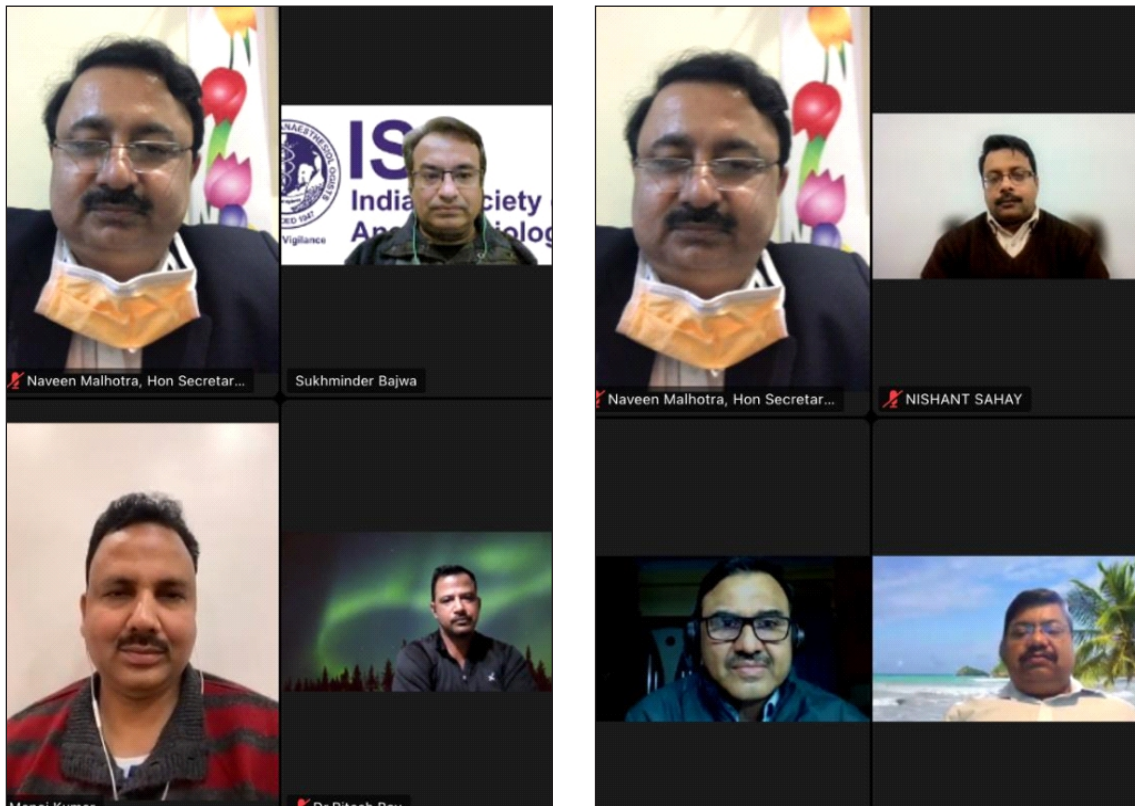

Greetings from ISA National Head Quarters !



Subject: Pattern of NEET Super Speciality (NEET-SS) 2022 Examination for the Superspeciality of Critical Care Medicine.

Respected Sir,
Greetings from Indian Society of Anaesthesiologists National Head Quarters !

Indian Society of Anaesthesiologists (ISA), the largest body of Anaesthesiologists in India with more than 36,000 members and 225 branches across India, represents clinical, academic and social issues pertaining to anaesthesiologists in India. The anaesthesiologists have worked dedicatedly in the critical care of COVID patients in critical care units in the ongoing COVID pandemic.

As per the notification of National Board of Examinations in Medical Sciences dated 1/11/2021, the NEET Super Speciality (NEET-SS) 2022 examination is to be held in June 2022. According to the revised pattern of the examination, DM/DrNB in Critical Care Medicine (CCM) can be opted for by the candidates belonging to Anaesthesiology, General Medicine, Respiratory Medicine, Emergency Medicine and Paediatrics.

Further, as per the suggested examination pattern, General Medicine (and its sub-specialities like cardiology, neurology etc.) has been identified as the only feeder specialty for Critical Care Medicine. This arrangement does not consider Honourable Supreme Court's directive that the entrance questions should be from feeder specialities, which for Critical Care Medicine have been identified as Anaesthesiology, General Medicine, Respiratory Medicine, Emergency Medicine and Paediatrics.

Moreover, the suggested arrangement would rule out inclusion of MD/DNB exit level questions from Anaesthesiology, Respiratory Medicine, Emergency Medicine and Pediatrics, putting students from these specialities to a great disadvantage. As a result, brilliant students from these specialities may not be able to get admission in DM/DrNB Critical Care Medicine. Also, taking a note to the revised

examination pattern, which states that the NEET SS CCM entrance examination shall comprise of questions from General Medicine only makes it totally biased towards one speciality despite Critical Care Medicine being the Superspeciality branch to many other specialties including Anaesthesiology.

This proposed new pattern of examination almost closes the avenue for the students from Anaesthesiology, Respiratory Medicine and Emergency Medicine to take up DM/DrNB Critical Care Medicine. It is common knowledge that over 70% or more Critical Care Medicine trainees come from Anaesthesia stream and many others from chest/respiratory medicine. Traditionally students from General Medicine background have been opting for branches like cardiology, nephrology, gastroenterology, etc. and Critical Care Medicine remains a low priority, which can be verified from National Board of Examinations in Medical Sciences admission records of Critical Care Medicine. Under the new scheme of things, it is feared that the speciality of Critical Care Medicine may undergo an undesirable metamorphosis with significant number of seats going vacant affecting not only capacity building but also jeopardising career prospects of young anaesthesiologists.

As The Indian Society of Anaesthesiologists, we are concerned about the future of Critical Care Medicine and Anaesthesiologists in India and urge your good office to kindly reconsider the proposal and revert it back to existing pattern in the interest of fair play amongst all feeder specialties in particular and Critical Care Medicine super speciality in general.

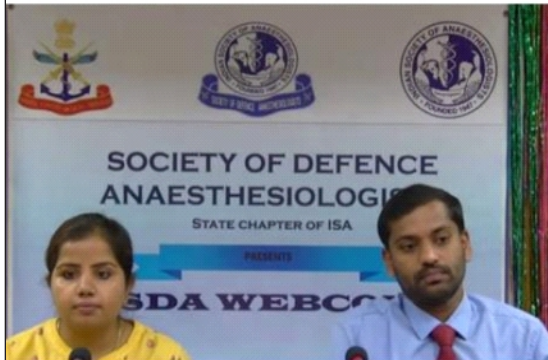
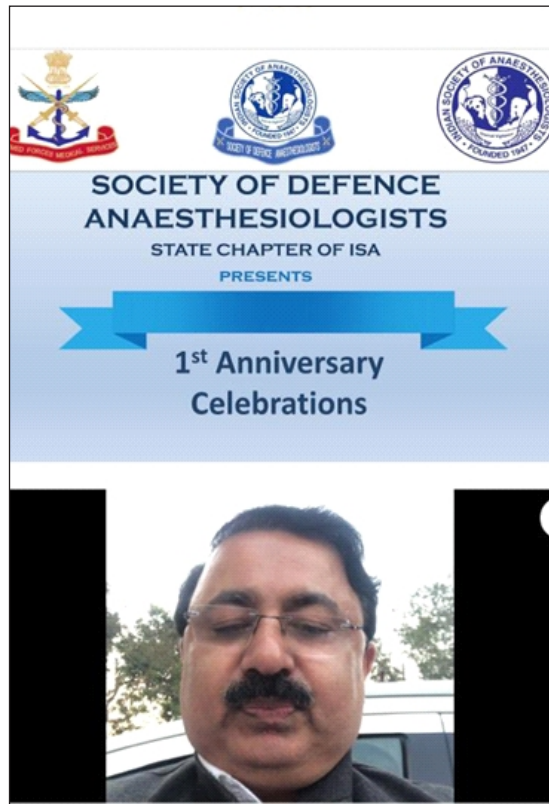
"Members of Society of Defence Anaesthesiologists are deployed in challenging environments not only in India but beyond our borders in UN Peace Keeping Missions. In these austere environments our Anaesthesiologists are doing a commendable job in resuscitating, managing and transporting a wide variety of cases. Difficulties faced include harsh weather, lack of specialised manpower, equipment and transport. This newsletter gives a glimpse of a few such cases managed by us over the last year.

Management of a Degloving Injury in an isolated and resource limited situation

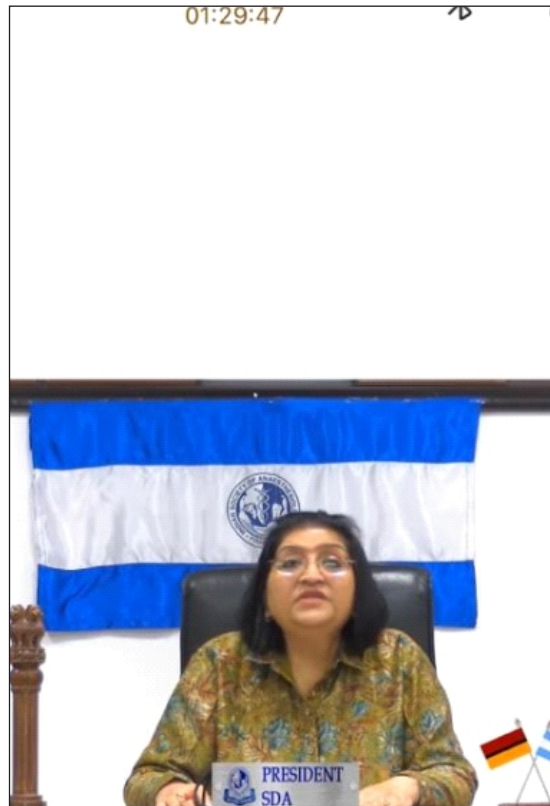
Maj Manpreet Singh, Siliguri, West Bengal

31 y/o serving soldier, with no known comorbidities, presented in the emergency room after sustaining a grenade blast injury of the right hand. After initial resuscitation with crystalloids 2L, patient was taken to OT for haemostasis and limb conservation surgery. Anaesthetic challenges included massive hemorrhage, shock, pain, poor venous access, full stomach patient. In view of patient's pain status and emergent requirement of haemostasis, general anaesthesia with endotracheal intubation was administered. We followed rapid sequence induction and intubation. Central venous access was obtained and noradrenaline infusion started to manage hypotension. Subsequently one unit whole blood was transfused intraoperatively. Haemostasis was secured and debridement done over the next 3 hours by the surgeon. Intraoperatively, a landmark guided supraclavicular nerve block was given. The operative course was uneventful. One unit whole blood was transfused in the post-operative period also.

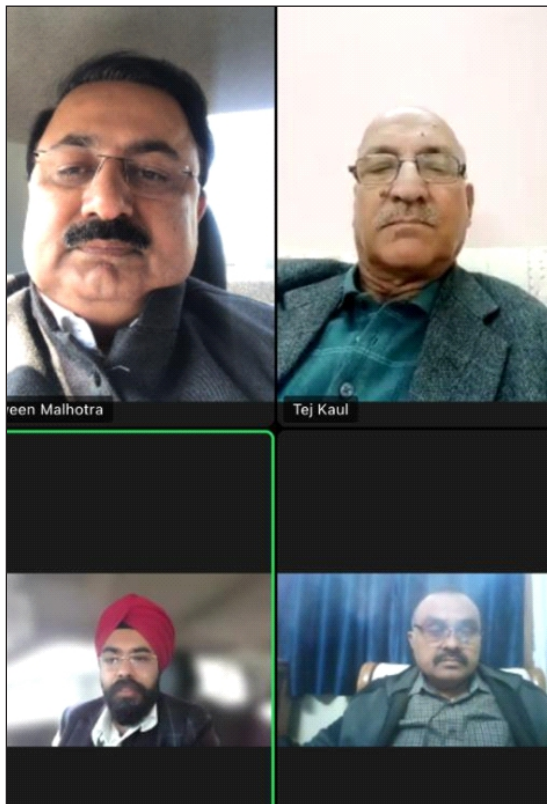

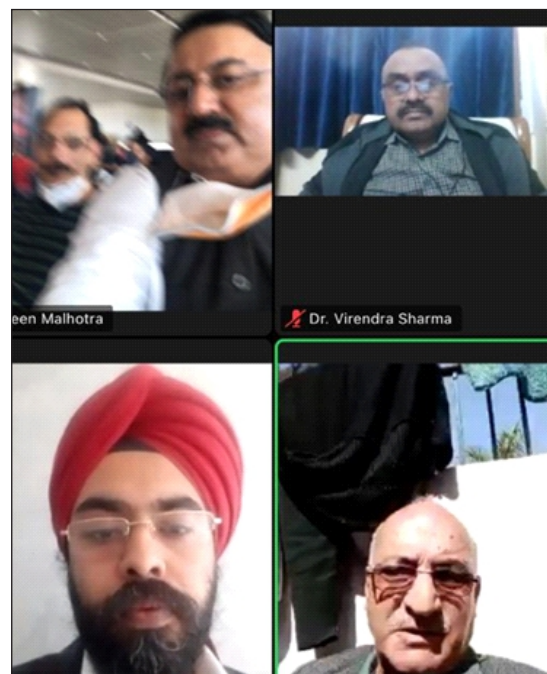

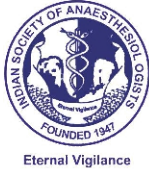
